

Blood Drive Options

Bloodmobile



The blood bank is on the move daily with a 34-foot bloodmobile traveling to neighborhoods throughout Oahu.

Our 34-foot bloodmobile, donated by Foodland and the Sullivan Family, conveniently brings the donation experience to communities and neighborhoods throughout Oahu every day. This type of drive is most suitable for organizations that have the following:

- ◆ Fifty or more scheduled appointments, with two to three donors scheduled every 15 minutes
- ◆ A level parking area large enough to host a 34-foot vehicle – approximately 10 parking stalls
- ◆ Restroom facilities nearby

In-House Drive

If your organization has the right facilities, the Blood Bank of Hawaii nursing staff can set up a mobile-collection site on your premises. This provides employees with a convenient opportunity to donate. An in-house drive would be most suitable for organizations that have the following:

- ◆ At least 50 donor appointments with three to six donors scheduled every 15 minutes
- ◆ A cool, well-lit room at least 25 feet by 30 feet in size
- ◆ Restroom facilities nearby and ample electrical outlets
- ◆ Use of tables and chairs available

Dillingham/ Downtown Donor Center

Your organization can conduct a blood drive by sending donors to the Blood Bank of Hawaii's fixed sites at 2043 Dillingham Blvd. or 126 Queen St. in downtown Honolulu. To conduct this type of blood drive, your organization should provide:

- ◆ A minimum of 10 or more appointments with one to two donors scheduled every 15 minutes
- ◆ Clear directions and possibly shuttle transportation to the donor center
