## Unmasking Hawaii's Heroes

Every two seconds someone in the United States needs blood. Here in Hawaii, we need about 200 donors every single day to roll up their sleeves to meet patients' blood needs throughout the state. Blood does not grow on trees and cannot be manufactured in a lab. It comes from one source— volunteer donors.

Blood is a perishable and fragile product. The needs change daily depending on hospital usage and patient situations. Every blood type and all blood components (red blood cells, plasma and platelets) are necessary. Whether it's a whole blood donation



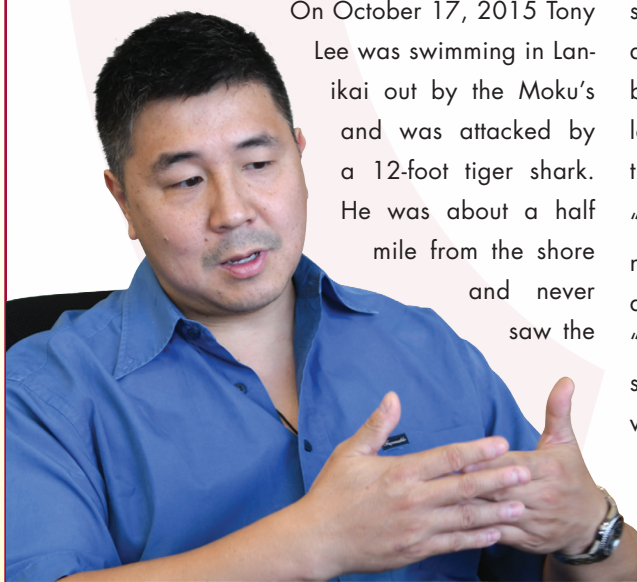
every couple of months or a specific component collected through a process called apheresis every couple of weeks, each time a donor walks in our doors, they are making a difference for our community.

In Hawaii, more than 21,000 people donate blood. When we call, they

## Whole New World



On October 17, 2015 Tony Lee was swimming in Lanikai out by the Moku's and was attacked by a 12-foot tiger shark. He was about a half mile from the shore and never saw the

shark coming. He fought and fought. He was dragged down in the water, his ears popped, and both his legs were in the shark's mouth. When one leg snapped Tony was able to turnaround and face the tiger.

"My business is we work with eyes. Biosynthetic corneas. I have a lot of experience taking eyes out of animals. Sounds weird to say that," Tony shared. "I went for the shark's eyes, got loose and swam to surface. Felt like it took years to get to there but it was probably only a few seconds."

## APHERESIS DONORS

Apheresis donors donate specific blood components through an automated process. They donate what the patient needs at their time of donation and the other components are circulated back into their body. Apheresis donors can donate a maximum 24 times a year and spend anywhere from 45 to 90 minutes on the bed. That's dedication!

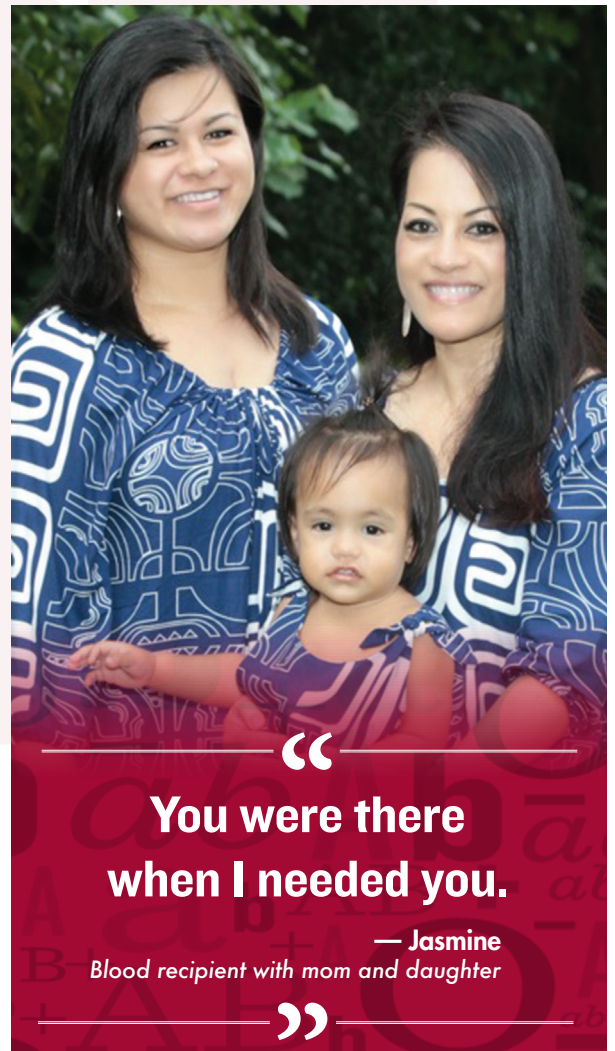

A man and his son came out of nowhere answering Tony's cry for help. Julian Liverton and his son Charlie picked him up. Julian used his rash guard as a tourniquet while Charlie made it to shore. The ambulance was on its way by the time Tony and Julian arrived.

"When I got to the hospital I was almost out of blood, and they pumped eight liters of blood in me," Tony recounted. "My friends had made it to the hospital. Walking through the hallways, they saw me and said, 'I can't believe you are still alive.'"

Tony said, "Hey I'm doing good. A little bit of blood really helps out! "

I would not be alive today without that blood. If I could meet those donors, I would say thank you for donating blood because you saved my life. You gave me a second chance at life."

Since then Tony used more blood and has gone through seven surgeries.

Today Tony is really making the most of his new lease on life. He rode 25 miles of the Honolulu century bike ride, completed the Waimea Rough Water Swim, and kayaked and camped on the Napali Coast. For him, it's not just about enjoying life to the fullest but making a difference for others too.

"I'm glad to be alive. The fact that I only have one leg is very challenging. But I am a mechanical engineer. I'm a bio-engineer. It opens a whole new world of possibilities. Designing new prosthetic legs. New ways to compensate and make use of what's available.

Helping others to face these challenges and not give up what they love doing."

Blood donors gave Tony a second chance at life and Tony is doing everything he can to ensure others who have lost a leg have opportunities and possibilities to make the most of theirs.

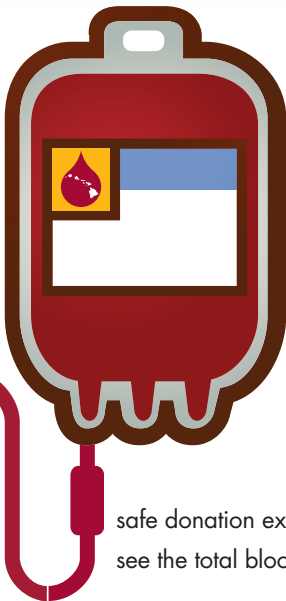


# Sweet 16



Nationwide many blood donors have started their legacy of saving lives at 16 years old. As of January 29, 2017, donors who are 16 years old will be able to donate with parental consent. As Hawaii’s high school juniors join the ranks of lifesaving heroes, BBH has launched an educational campaign to ensure our youngest blood donors are well prepared and have a great first time donation experience.

# In the Bag

To conform to the blood bank industry standard blood bag, BBH will change to the slightly larger 500mL bag. The change is seamless for donors and hospitals. A few donors will be impacted by the eligibility requirements, noted below which were implemented to ensure a safe donation experience for donors. # Community Support
